## **1. PRODUCTS** If you are interested in our

Glamping Tents

Caravans

Storage Cabins

Office Pods

then depending on use, state, council, permits are either not required or should be easier to obtain. If you want to know if we can handle it for you then please provide the information from you below.

## **2. PARK SITES** If your interest is in purchasing a habitable dwelling whether for temporary, casual, commercial, or full time use located in a Caravan Park, Cabin Park, or MHE (Manufactured Housing Estate) permits are pretty easy and there is a reasonable chance we can handle it all for you once we get some initial information below.

## **3. ALL OTHER SITES** If your interest is in purchasing a dwelling whether for temporary, casual, commercial, or full time use located in normal residential, farming, rural, locations, then :

**IF** it is a registered as a Caravan, registered as a Boat, or a Glamping tent, there may be no permits needed (but conditions that have to be adhered to), or a pretty simple permit process if needed is likely.

**IF** it is a conventional structure however there can be quite a bit of work involved with permits.

If needed we will provide information that relates to our products such as, Engineering, Plans, Thermal Efficiency information.

But most of the information required for permits will be unique to your site.

Your options are :

- Appoint architects or town planners and they will do it all for you, and liaise with us re the information they need from us.
- We send you a list to identify what we believe the key tasks are, but you do the running around yourself dealing with the various regulatory authorities and consultants.
